Submission Guidelines:

The presentation title, abstract (up to 250 words), and author biography (up to 200 words) are to be submitted on-line via the Unmanned Systems Canada website at <https://unmannedsystems.ca/unmanned-canada-abstract-submission/>. Selection Process:

The conference technical committee will select presentations based on the submitted information, and notify authors via email by June 22 2018. It is understood that abstracts may be preliminary at the time of submission owing to incomplete research, trials, etc. Authors may refine their abstracts up until the conference booklet publication deadline of October 12, 2018. Significant changes to a topic may be subject to further technical committee review.

Reduced Conference Registration Fee:

Speakers are entitled to a significantly reduced registration fee that reflects Unmanned Systems Canada's direct costs for each attendee. This reduced fee provides the speaker with access to the full conference program.
